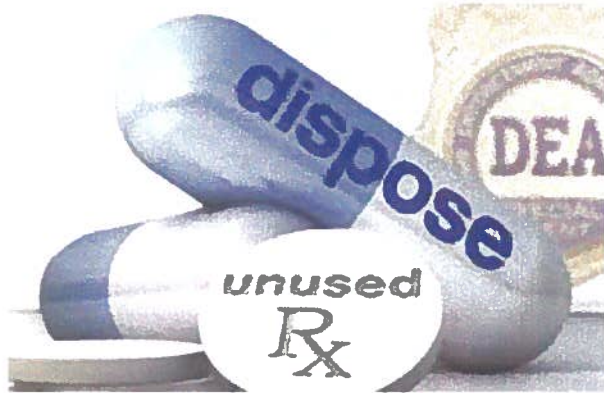

Drop Off Your Prescription Drugs at the Village Center Saturday, April 27, 2019 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.

The Village Center will once again be a host site for **National Prescription Drug Take-Back Day** on Saturday, April 27. A Montgomery County Police officer will be here to collect and safely dispose of your unwanted or expired prescription drugs. (**Look for the officer in the Village Center lobby.**)



The prescription drug take-back program, sponsored by the Drug Enforcement Administration, addresses a vital public safety and public health issue. Medicines in home cabinets are highly susceptible to diversion, misuse, and

abuse. Studies show that a majority of abused prescription drugs are obtained from family and friends, including from the home medicine cabinet.
