Village survey

Bob wondered if we could have an online one-question survey regarding 55550 development; committee members discussed whether it would be possible to ensure only one survey per resident would be completed; Bob felt that asking the Program Advisory Committee members if they would complete the survey is not a very good way of predicting how the average resident will respond
