

Community Advisory Committee Minutes
October 12, 2022

Meeting was held via Zoom and called to order at 5:30 pm.

Topics:

1. Attendees discussed observations since last meeting. Of note:
 - a. Status of the proposed Dog Park on Willard Avenue
 - b. Resignation of the County Planning Board
 - c. Electronic Vehicle charging station plans / presence in buildings
 - d. The Willoughby having good turn-out for its non-smoking rule change.
2. Received update on Red House status from Council Member Al Muller.
 - a. Committee will develop a survey to be issued to the Village to elicit input on use for presentation to Village Council. There may be several open meetings for discussion.
 - b. Committee is interested in a tour of the building once feasible to aid in its discussion.
3. Committee reviewed the details of a proposed competition to design the statement sign for the Village to replace the current bulletin board. Committee members agreed to be involved in the process by reviewing submissions and selecting the best 3 – 5 for a recommendation to the Village Council for final selection.
 - a. The Committee recommends some type of award for the winner, possibly a Village sponsored class.
4. To meet the schedules of a broader cross-section of the Village, the Committee has started to discuss shifting its meeting time later and / or day to accommodate those that work and with families.
