The meeting was held via Zoom and called to order at 6:00 pm.

Topics:

- Committee Roundtable:
 - Council Member Cheryl Tyler introduced as Council Liaison.
 - 4615 had two intruders enter their garage and puncture holes in gas tanks. Fire and Police responded.
 - Committee requests review of post and rails at Willoughby Park. They are rusting at the base in various places and unsteady.
 - 4620 roof work will be completed soon alleviating congestion on N. Park Ave.
 - There is a tree on Shoemaker Farm Lane that has balloons in the canopy. Committee requests that they be removed to maintain the appearance of the Village. There is also a tree on Somerset Terrace with material in the canopy.
 - The Willoughby Town Hall regarding the Sprinkler Mandate was discussed. Information was shared. Chair, Joe Bucherer outlined discussions regarding a state wide initiative to modify the mandate based on costs and facts regarding building structures.
 - Request per the June meeting to review the need for additional stops for the shuttle bus. The Committee feels this requires review before the construction at 5500 Wisconsin which will make walking to appointments difficult.
 - The Committee discussed issues related to the 2033 Sprinkler Mandate.
 - Council Member Cheryl Tyler addressed the Committee regarding its discussion.
 - The Presidents of the buildings will be meeting on July 13th to discuss initiatives regarding safety monitoring and the Sprinkler mandate.
