Topics:

- Committee Roundtable:
  - Interest in development of a plan to coordinate periodic household goods collection with groups like Salvation Army, Goodwill, etc.
  - Appreciation for modification of Village Shuttle route for Willard Towers. Disappointment in learning of the noise restriction associated with the back-up safety warning.
  - 4620 celebrated its 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary.
  - Discussion of development along Wisconsin Ave. and potential of positive change for the area.
  - Discussion of Red House and opportunities to expand search for renter beyond bakery / coffee shop.
  
- Village “Quality of Life” Survey:
  - Members asked to reinforce within their buildings.
  - Committee members met with residents during Farmer’s Market. Peak times for interaction were 10 – 11 am. Several people took hard copies of the survey.
  - Committee would like to see an extension of one-week to pick up additional responses.
