Notes

- **Council Updates:**
 - End of April the ADA changes should be ready and the Red Building will open soon after in accordance with the established schedule
 - County changes are being made to Paige Park to include taking the pergola down and a new permit is needed. It is due to open in later summer/early fall.
- **Building/Community Updates:**
 - Snow clearing issues - main roads are largely cleared but crosswalks are not nor are some smaller roads in the area. Friendship Heights snow has done a relatively good job relative to other areas in clearing the snow and ice.
 - Issues have arisen with the 4620 HVAC project.
- **New Initiative Project:** The group discussed the process for scoring the new initiatives.
 - Since there was insufficient time to go through each proposal in one meeting (as there are 9 proposals this year) the group decided to request an extension for scoring and to each read and take an initial cut on scoring the proposals individually at home prior to the next CAC meeting.

Action items

- Request an extension for Scoring the Proposals: The request has been made and an extension has been granted. The group will continue the discussion of the proposals at the next CAC meeting in March.
- Individual CAC member proposal scores will be submitted following the CAC meeting in March. Two members from the CAC will average the scores and submit all composite scores to the Council for consideration.
